#### **POT LUCK PAGE**

Corn Casserole (from the kitchen of Becky Lunde)

- 1 stick margarine
- 18-oz pkg. cream cheese
- 1 egg
- 1 can whole corn, drained
- 1 can cream style corn
- 1 Tablespoon sugar
- 1 Box Jiffy Corn Muffin Mix




#### Regular Oven:

Melt margarine and cream cheese. Add egg and stir together. Add remaining ingredients. Spray with Pam a large 9x13 glass casserole dish and bake at 350 degrees for 1 hour till done.

#### **Convection Oven:**

Press Bake/Roast button once. To set the temperature, press 7 for 350 degrees. Press OK. Set time for 45 min to cook. Turn Off Turntable. Press Start.

**RV TIP:** Want your RV Air Conditioner to run smoother and last longer? It is recommended to clean your AC every six months. Turn off Air Conditioners. Carefully remove the cover. Now remove the coil cover. There may be some screws to remove that you will need a long handle Phillips screwdriver to reach. There will be some clips to undo. Slide the cover out. You will see the coils are covered with a dirty goo. Wipe this off with paper towels and a toothbrush. Make sure to get all the goo off the tray below. Now spray the coils with "Nu-Calgon Evaporator Foam No Rinse Evaporator Coil Cleaner" available on Amazon. Let it sit for one hour. Put everything back together.


