Minutes of the Business Meeting for Escapees Chapter 57 Sun Gators



The Business Meeting was called to order at 09:30 November 7, 2022 by Nathan Colter, President. Introduction of Officers: Nathan Colter, President; Judy Hoffman, Vice-President; Rose Irons, Secretary; and Debby Thompson, Treasurer. Pledge of Allegiance was led by Nathan Colter followed by a moment of silence in respect to all our first responders. Vice President Report: Judy Hoffman presented a Congratulations Certificate for 10 years of service for Caring and Sharing with Escapees RV Club. Certificate signed by Travis Carr, President and Teresa Moore, COO. Secretary Report: Minutes from last business meeting in April 2022 emailed to members, on website, and in Gator Tales Newsletter. No questions or corrections noted. Motion to accept Secretary Report by Chick Thompson, second by John McKean. Motion carried. Rose Irons reminded everyone to please contact her or Debby Thompson with any change in address, email or phone number. Treasurers Report: Debby Thompson reported that Treasurers Report was emailed to members and posted on webpage and Gator Tales Newsletter. No questions or corrections noted. Motion to accept Treasurers Report made by Chick Thompson, Second by Becky Lunde. Motion carried. Annual Audit was done by Treasurer and members Judy Hoffman, Rose Irons, and Nathan Colter as required by Escapees RV Club. Sunshine Report: Marylin Forbes sent out three get well cards since last meeting and read an appreciation card from Dick Hoelzel. Please contact Marilyn with information about illness or loss in Chapter 57. Facebook and RV Village: Chick Thompson informed us that Facebook page is now private again. New members requesting access, must answer two questions: 1. SKP number 2. Where you joined. Gator Tales: Becky Lunde reminded everyone next Gator Tales deadline is December 15th. Please send stories, pictures, recipes, and articles of interest to Becky. Old Business: No old business was presented. New Business: Rose and Dave Irons represented Chapter 57 at Escapade this year. In past years, we have compensated Row Reps by paying for camping fees. In reviewing our Bylaws, there is no written documentation that we are required to do this but an apparent verbal understanding as an incentive for volunteers. It has been noted in older minutes that Chapter 57 would pay camping fees. When row representation first started, it was a full week and 9-5 commitment. Currently, Row Reps are required to come in a day early for setup, but time spent on The Row has been drastically reduced. Average time on ROW is 9-2 and only 3 days. Floor discussion followed on best and fair way to encourage volunteers and compensation for their commitment to Chapter 57. Chick Thompson made a motion to pay 50% of camping fees for whatever site they choose (full hook-up, water & electric, or dry camping). This would include early arrival as required for setup. Compensation would also include expenses to decorate Row table and information about Chapter 57. Second, by Lynn Lunde. Motion carried. Nathan Colter asked members to promote Chapter 57 whenever possible. Talk up Chapter 57 and give away old issues of Escapees Magazine and tell folks about our webpage and Facebook page. Election of Officers: Duties of Vice President reviewed. Judy Hoffman was thanked for her service as Vice President and given a round of applause. The floor was opened for nominations for Vice President. There were no volunteers for Vice President. Office will remain vacant. Treasurer: The floor was opened by nominations for Treasurer. Rose Irons nominated Debby Thompson and she accepted. A call for other nominations was asked three times. Motion to accept Debby Thompson for Treasurer for next two-year term made by Chick Thompson and second by John McKean. Motion carried. Several members asked about having more Escapades on the East Coast. It was noted that is very hard to find affordable and adequate accommodations. Meeting adjourned at 10:30. POT LUCK PAGE

Buttermilk Cinnamon Bread (From Becky's Kitchen!)

4 Cups Flour 2 tsp. Baking Soda 1 tsp. Salt 2 Eggs ¹/₂ Cups Raisins (optional) 1/2 Cup Veg. Oil like Canola 2 ½ Cups Sugar – divided 2 Cups Buttermilk 1 Tbsp. Cinnamon



Combine dry ingredients (except Cinnamon). In another bowl combine oil and 1 ½ cups Sugar. Add buttermilk and eggs. Stir into dry ingredients. Fill two greased 8"x14" or five 5"x2" loaf pans about 1/3 full. Combine cinnamon and remaining sugar. Sprinkle half over batter. Top with remaining batter and cinnamon-sugar. Swirl batter with knife. Bake 350 for 45-55 min. Yield 2 loaves or 5 mini loaves. (Wrap cooled bread in foil and freeze up to 3 months). This recipe is delicious and easy to make. Since it makes two loaves, the second loaf can be used as a gift. Wrap it in foil, tie it in a pretty bow, and wah-la, you make someone very happy!
