Escapade 2024 Row Information – From Wendy Stanwood, Chapter/BOF Director

Arrival: All representatives for the Row should arrive by the morning of Saturday, June 15th. If your Escapade welcome packet states your arrival for June 16th, please contact the registration office to let them know you are a Row Rep and must arrive on the 15th.

Set-up: Times for set-up on June 15th are from 10am to 2pm. The Row will be easily found on the Escapade map. The Row will be in the Hospitality Room. You will be provided with a table and two chairs. For your exhibit you will supply your own brochures, visual arrangements, banners, table-clothes, etc. All this must fit within your booth space, so bear that in mind. Electrical outlets are not normally available, so please make sure to charge up all computers and battery powered devices that you may need during the Row hours.

Row Social Hour: June 15th at 4:00pm, the Row Social Hour will be held in an area to be determined at the fairgrounds. You will be notified of the location during Row set-up that morning. This is a time to socialize and meet your fellow reps. Snacks will be provided, and you will only need to bring your beverage of choice with you.

Row hours: The Row will be open from Sunday, June 16th, through Wednesday, June 20th. The hours of operation are 10am to 2pm. During the open hours of the Row, it will be **REQUIRED** that at least one person be manning the booth. If you wish to rotate personnel, that is acceptable if it is a member with knowledge of your group. An unmanned booth is not helpful to interested parties and detracts from the purpose of the Row, which is to tell others about your group.

Gifts/drawings: You are NOT required to provide a drawing or gift and is strictly up to your Chapter or BoF. However, if you choose to do so, all Row gifts are to be kept within the Row to giveaway. They will not be given away during the nightly drawings which are reserved for the vendors and parks. "Must be present to win" drawings are discouraged due to many members attending seminars during the open hours of Row. It is suggested that you obtain phone numbers of the entrants to make the giveaways easier for contact purposes.

If you wish to donate an item for giveaway for the end of the Row during the Row Rep drawings, please contact us beforehand.

Frequently Asked Questions about Row at Escapade

Q: What is the Row?

A: The Row began in the early years of Escapade when some enterprising members of Escapees chapters and BoFs (Birds of a Feather) placed tables outside of their rows of RVs to tell others about their groups. Today's Row is held inside and includes all the chapters, BoFs, SKP parks and co-ops that gathers for four days of Escapade to share all the greatness of their groups.

Q: Do we have to provide our own tables and chairs?

A: No, a table and two chairs will be provided for you. You are welcome to bring your own chairs if you prefer. You are encouraged to decorate within your space with any banner, flag, tablecloths, displays, etc. that fit within your area.

Q: What are the responsibilities of a Row Rep?

A: Those can be found online in the Chapter Manual by logging in as a member to escapees.com and going to https://member.escapees.com/community/chapters/forms. Click on the Chapter Manual link and go to page 33 to find those responsibilities. Any changes to those responsibilities will be given to you by your chapter director prior to Escapade or at any time during the event.

Q: Is there a discount for Escapade for being a Row Rep?

A: No, there is not.

Q: What are the hours of Row?

A: Row Reps arrive on the Saturday before Escapade begins to get set up. The Row runs Sunday through Tuesday from 10am to 2pm each day.

Q: Can a table be set up and left unattended?

- A: No. The table MUST be always manned by at least one knowledgeable member that the Row is open.
- Q: Do we have to give out goodies... candy, stickers, etc.?
- A: No, you do not. It does help draw people to your table and many groups do, but it is not required.

Q: Are we allowed to sell or raffle anything on the Row for donations to CARE?

A: Per the Escapees legal department, there is no selling allowed on the Row for any reason due to the varying laws from state to state.

Q: What do we need the most on the Row?

A: Smiling faces. This is not an exaggeration, because people are naturally attracted to friendliness.

Q: Is there electricity available?

A: This varies from location to location, so therefore prepare as if there is no electricity available at your table. If you wish to use a computer at your table, recharge the batteries prior to each day.

Q: Do the Row Reps have to come to the Row Social Hour on Saturday prior to Escapade?

A: We won't make you come, but we'll certainly miss you.

Q: How do we sign up as Row Reps?

A: When you register with National, you will let them know that you must arrive on Saturday. Then you will notify the Chapter Directors at chapterdirectors@escapees.com to be placed on the rep list.

Q: We've heard that there was a "parade of banners" in the past. Does this still occur?

A: No, there is no longer a parade during opening ceremonies. However, you are encouraged to display your flag or banner at your Row table.

Q: How do we know where to park or go when we arrive?

A: There are many friendly Escapade volunteers that will assist you in getting parked and maps to guide you everywhere you will need to go, including the Row.

Q: Will we get more information as Escapade nears?

A: You'll get tired of hearing from us, but you'll not be short on information. And you're always welcome to send an email to ask anything you wish.
