CARE donations: The Chapter received a letter and patch from CARE because of our donation from the November Rally. The lifetime total stated on the letter is \$21,920.10. If you have our prior patches, will you let me know so I can add this to the collection. We also received a separate letter acknowledging our \$569.00 in donations for 2022. FYI for new members, patches are issued to Chapters from CARE for each \$1000 in donations. Member's donations are also recognized by CARE. When members donations total \$100 or more, they will receive a letter and CARE pins to recognize their donations. Those whose donations total \$1,000.00 or more will receive a larger pin to thank them for their donations and a name plaque will be placed on the wall in the entrance to CARE showing they are \$1,000 donors. The member's donations only count if no goods or services were received for their donation. If you donate at a rally, I have a way to report it so the Chapter and you gets credit for the donation. 
